PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Kingdom Kids is a unique ministry (ages 4 years through 6th grade) that invites children to experience the stories of the Bible in fun and engaging ways. Children share a family style meal together in small groups where they quickly learn they are an important part of community. Our leaders bring the stories of the Bible to life through dramas, games, and real life applications. Our kids also participate in an exciting worship time, and earn points to spend periodically at the eagerly anticipated “store night.”

As the parent/legal guardian, I am responsible for and agree to the following rules and policies as a condition of my child participating in Kingdom Kids:

SCHEDULE & CLOSURE POLICY

Kingdom Kids runs from 5:45pm until 7:15pm on Wednesday evenings from September through May each year. The schedule parallels the calendar of the local public schools in terms of holiday/breaks, as well as closures for inclement weather.

- ❖ If Albemarle County Schools is closed (such as in the case of inclement weather), there will be no Kingdom Kids for that evening.
- ❖ Should parent(s)/legal guardians have any questions about openings/closures, information can be found on Church’s website (www.Broadus.org) and by calling the Church (977-7381). Updates will be posted by 2pm on the evening of Kingdom Kids.

AVAILABILITY OF PARENT(S)/LEGAL GUARDIAN(S)

- ❖ The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of each child agrees to remain on the church premises or be available by phone at the number(s) listed on the front of this form throughout the duration of the program each evening.
- ❖ Drop-off and Pick-up Rules: The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) of each child should ensure that their child arrives promptly at the church by no later than 5:45pm and agree to pick up their child promptly at the conclusion of each evening’s activities at 7:15pm. If the child is using the Church bus for transportation to/from Wilton Farm, parent(s)/legal guardian(s) agree to have their child(ren) ready on time at the designated bus pick-up (pick-up ~ 5:30pm) AND to be present when their child(ren) are dropped off by the bus (drop offs will occur between 7:20-7:30pm).

ILLNESS POLICY

- ❖ Children will not be permitted to attend and participate in evening activities at Kingdom Kids if they have had any of the following in the preceding 24 hours: contagious illnesses, open sores/rashes, discharge from nose/eyes, vomiting/diarrhea, or fever

EMERGENCY TREATMENT CONSENT

- ❖ If Kingdom Kids staff is unable to contact a child’s parent/legal guardian or designated emergency contact in the event of serious illness or injury to the child, the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) give consent to the administration to secure emergency medical care.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- ❖ Children may be photographed while participating in the Kingdom Kids program. Pictures may be used internally for program-related activities and in media to describe our program, such as for Church recognition of the Kingdom Kids program. If parent(s)/legal guardian(s) do not wish for their child(ren) to be photographed, they must notify Kingdom Kids administration of this in writing.
